We operate a full pay bar and your guests are able to pay with card, Apple Pay, Google Pay or cash.

Typically we open for your guests arrival or after your ceremony and close at 11:30pm.

Our comprehensive bar offers your guests a wide range of beers, ciders, wines, cocktails, craft spirits and soft drinks including premium draught beers.
